behind the establishment of Hospice of Southern Maine. Following her retirement from medical practice, Anne felt a profound calling to ministry, and in 2006, she answered that call by becoming an ordained deacon through the Deacon Formation Program of the Diocese of Maine.

During her final days, Anne was tenderly cared for by Hospice of Southern Maine, a fitting testament to her life's work. Through her foresight and generosity, she established an endowment to advance education and address the spiritual dimensions of healthcare at life's end. In recognition of her commitment, the Thresholds Educational Conference now bears her name as a lasting tribute to her legacy.

who never once questioned her faith until she
was close to death, to the older man seeing
visions of his late daughter, to the young
patient who laments that she spent too much
of her short life worrying about what others
thought of her.
